### Artistic Director & Staff

#### Roma Pryma Bohachevsky

...has been on the dance scene in Glen Spey for over 29 years, and in 2004, is celebrating her 40th Anniversary teaching Ukrainian Dance in the United States! Every summer, dance students come from all parts of the United States, Canada, and abroad to benefit from the tutelage of this internationally recognized choreographer and instructor. Many join the Dance Camp "family" as children, and continue their studies at Workshop into their teen and adult years.

A very accomplished Ukrainian ballerina, Roma Pryma began her studies in Lviv, Ukraine, and completed them at the **Academy of Music in Vienna, Austria**. During her brilliant dancing career, she performed extensively in Europe, with highlights in Athens, Geneva, Paris, Munich and London. In Austria, she was prima ballerina with the **State Opera in Innsbruck**,

As choreographer, she is noted for many ballets including **Cinderella, Kvit Paporoti, Peer Gynt, Fight for Freedom**. and **Icon**, a dramatic creation celebrating the millennium of Christianity in Ukraine.

At each summer camp, Mrs. Bohachevsky brings to life a Fairy Tale, weaving traditional and classical themes with imaginative staging, choreography, and costumes.

Mrs. Bohachevsky is the Founder and Artistic Director of **Syzokryli Ukrainian Dance Ensemble**, New York, numerous Ukrainian Dance Schools in the New York metropolitan area, and of the summer dance programs of Verkhovyna and Soyuzivka Resorts. She has been recognized by the New York Council of the Arts for her contributions in educating children in dance, and is awarded grants annually to support her work.

**Andrij Cybyk** ...started his formal Ballet training at the **Akron University Conservatory of Ballet** and his Character Dance training from the **Kashtan Ukrainian Dance Ensemble**. In 1986, he began studying with Roma Pryma Bohachevsky.

Andrij attended **Duquesne University**, graduating Summa cum laude, where he was a member of the **Tamburitzans**, having had the opportunity to work with the best folk artists and choreographers in the world. Andrij went on to study at the school of the **Ukrainian State Folk Ensemble, Virski**, in Kiev, Ukraine graduating with the title Artist of Ballet.

Andrij performs with **Michael Mao Dance, Ni Ni Chen, Anglo American Ballet, Connecticut Ballet, The New Jersey Ballet** (guest artist) and the **All Nations Dance Company**. He is Assistant Artistic Director and contributing choreographer for the **Syzokryli Ukrainian Dance Ensemble**. Andrij recently completed a six week residency program teaching character dance at **Stephens College** in Missouri.

**Kristine Izak** ...brings to Workshop over 13 years of professional teaching experience in a variety of dance forms. She earned her B.A. Summa cum laude in Dance from **DeSales University** and since that time, has taught at private dance schools in the Philadelphia area.

Kristine began her character dance training at the Voloshky School and in 1984 began performing with the **Voloshky Ukrainian Dance Ensemble**. In 1988 she attended her first Workshop and began dancing with **Syzokryli Ukrainian Dance Ensemble**, including on tour with them in Ukraine. She is proud to inspire her students through her teaching and choreography, and mentors many in careers in dance. This coming May, her work entitled **Reach** will be presented at the closing ceremonies for the national fund raising event "**Race for the Cure**" at the Philadelphia Museum of Art.

For over 29 years, WORKSHOP has been the most popular summer Ukrainian dance program for teens and young adults in the country. Daily classes in both character and ballet technique are followed by rigorous rehearsals where students learn sophisticated choreography and refine their performing skills.

WORKSHOP is also "The Summer Home of Syzokryli," the New York based ensemble founded by Roma Pryma Bohachevsky in 1974. Participants are given the opportunity to learn some of the exciting dances that are unique to the Ensembles repertoire.

The WORKSHOP concludes with performances at the Verkhovyna Youth Festival, a weekend event that attracts thousands of visitors from the U.S. and Canada.

An audition is not necessary for acceptance, but participants are recommended to have at least an intermediate knowledge of Ukrainian dance or equivalent experience in another dance form.
